Tasks:

We have gotten shifts for security and cleaning-crew. Tasks that can be assigned within these positions can be for example:

Security:

- Security around the festival grounds – you will always be standing with/in the vicinity of a security guard. Must be 18 years or older.
- Security at the entrances – check the public's bags/purses for illegal objects. Here you'll be with several other volunteers. Must be 16 years or older.
- Shift times:
 - Shift 1: 10:00 – 17:00
 - Shift 2: 16:00 – 00:00
 - Shift 3: 00:00 – 08:00

Renovation (Cleaning Crew):

- Collect and sort garbage
- Empty and change garbage bags
- Assist with re-filling toilet paper and hand sanitizer in the toilets
- Must be at least 16 years old for all tasks regarding renovation
- Shift times:
 - Shift 1: 09:00 – 17:00
 - Shift 2: 16:00 – 00:00

Practical Information:

More detailed information will come. Currently this is what we know:

- Bus 34 takes you from Voldsløkka to Ekebergsletta and home again (applies to all shifts)

- Meet-up at Ekeberg 30 minutes before the start of your shift
- You'll be well received at Ekebergsletta by the organizer at the check-in point, which is close to the bus stop.
- There will be organized breaks during the shift – take with you your own food and drink (it is also possible to buy food at the concert)
- Wear sensible work clothes and shoes – there will be t-shirts handed out.
